

Outdoor tent booth photos (10 x 20)

- ✓ Tents at National Mall from 3rd street-7th street, Freedom Plaza, Wilson Plaza, Pennsylvania Avenue will be in rows of 10 or more. 3 sides will be closed and one side will be open.
- ✓ As shown in the photo below, the end booths will have one vinyl wall and one pipe and drape wall. The booths in the middle will have pipe and drape on both sides. Colors of drape may vary depending on section.
- ✓ If you have multiple booths, side drapes can be removed. It is your responsibility to notify your preference by email.
- ✓ The frame of tent railing is 8' high. The peak of the tent top is 12'.



Indoor booth

- ✓ Tents at National Mall section 1 (NM-1) by Capitol reflecting pool are 30 x 80 tents with 18-20 pipe and drape booths inside.
- ✓ Mellon Auditorium have pipe and drape booths.
- ✓ The photo shown is sample image of a booth. Color of drapes and table cover material may vary. Carpeting or flooring is not included but available upon request at extra cost.
- ✓ If you have multiple booths, side drapes can be removed. It is your responsibility to notify your preference by email.



How to hang your banners

1. 8' Pipe and drape side wall
 - ✓ You can use S hooks, zip-ties, and/or ropes.
 - ✓ One side wall has 4 drapes. The pipe can be partially exposed by moving drapes.
 - ✓ S hook is used to hang a banner in the photo shown below.



2. 8' vinyl side wall for the end of the row booths
 - ✓ You can use zip-ties, ropes, and/or Velcro tapes.
 - ✓ Vinyl side walls have ropes attaching the top of the side wall to the roof of the tent. (Shown on the photo going zigzag) Your banners can be attached to the rope or to the top of the side walls.
 - ✓ Thin rope is used to hang a banner in the photo shown below.



3. 8' vinyl wall in the back of tent
 - ✓ You can use S hook, zip-ties, ropes and/or Velcro tapes.
 - ✓ Vinyl side walls have ropes attaching the top of the side wall to the roof of the tent. (Shown on the photo going zigzag) Your banners can be attached from the rope or from the top of the side walls.
 - ✓ Zip-tie is used to hang a banner in the photo shown below.

4. At the entrance of your tent
 - ✓ There is a frame underneath the valence where you can hang your banner. The valence can be flipped.
 - ✓ You can use S hook, zip-ties, ropes and/or Velcro tapes.
